### Vision

The programme will be run by the club with accredited coaches only (PGA registered or SADB approved).

The coaches will be responsible for drafting and implementing the development plan.

They together with the parents and the juniors must create an environment for the benefit of the juniors and the game of golf.

The programme is open to all ages up to 18, gender and background.

## **Programme Activities**

The programme must include the following:

- Golf Swing
- Correct Golf grip
- Short game techniques
- Putting
- Course management
- Golf Rules
- Dress code
- Golf etiquette.

## **Financial, membership, affiliation and handicap and playing fees,**

The cost of coaching will be free to all juniors

The cost of coaching will be paid from the golf development fund

Membership will be free to all juniors who have progressed to a level of competence to play a round of golf

Affiliation and handicap cost will be the responsibility of parents of juniors who have reached the level of competence and wishes to start playing in competitions. However, should a parent be in a position, due to financial constraints, that they are not able to pay these costs, requests can be submitted to the Golf Development coordinator to waive the costs. The request will be tabled at the Golf Operations sub-committee for approval and will be paid from the development fund.

The club will provide golf attire i.e. Golf shirt and Cap for juniors representing the club in official WP Golf junior competitions or other nationally or internationally recognised junior events as determined by the Golf Operations committee.

Developments players will be allowed to play on days other than competition days provided that they are under supervision of a recognised coach by prior arrangement with the development coordinator and the manager. Coaches with junior groups can arrange with the Club manager or Golf development coordinator for access to the course.

Any juniors representing WP, or competing in national / international events, may apply to the development coordinator to play practice rounds on the course on non-competition days at a nominal fee of R5 which is payable at the pro shop.

Juniors playing in club competitions must pay the green and competition fees as determined by the committee.

## **Coaching Days**

The course will be available for coaching on Tuesday from 14H00 – 17H00. Should all juniors not be accommodated on Tuesday, the coaches may arrange with the Manager for Thursdays if the course is available.
