**New SAGA Office Bearers announced**



CAPE TOWN, 26 April 2022 – Henk Smith was officially elected as the President of the South African Golf Association (SAGA) at the organisation’s Annual General Meeting held at Royal Johannesburg & Kensington Golf Club on Sunday, 24 April.

Smith took the reins as Acting President during August last year after the unexpected passing of former President Martin Saaiman, and his move into the role will be seamless.

The newly appointed President will be supported by Acting Senior Vice President Deon Nel from Eastern Province, who was elected Senior Vice President and new induction Peet van Schalkwyk from North West, who was elected Junior Vice President.

The trio will serve as the SAGA Office Bearers for the next 24 months.

In terms of his tenure as President, Smith intends to maintain the high standard achieved by the SAGA, GolfRSA and Womens Golf South Africa.

“I have been honoured to serve amateur golf for the last 15 years, and I look forward to the opportunity to build on the great work of my predecessors at the SAGA and GolfRSA,” said Smith, who was involved in administration at Western Province Golf since 2007 until he was elected Junior Vice President in 2019.

“It has been a privilege to be party to the SAGA's transition towards a professional structure in the past three years, and the successes we have celebrated. Deon and I have worked extremely well in tandem for the last nine months, and Peet will be a great addition to the team. As the former North West Golf Union President, and in his role on the SAGA Executive, Peet has proven himself as an experienced administrator with an unwavering passion for the game.

“Our priority will be to maintain the high standard we have achieved, and in collaboration with GolfRSA, we will continue to find new opportunities for golf. Furthermore, I want to continue the good communication between ourselves and Womens Golf South Africa (WGSA) as we work towards the furtherance of golf in South Africa.”

The SAGA and WGSA are stakeholders of GolfRSA and is responsible for administering, operating and providing services to amateur golf in South Africa.

GolfRSA CEO Grant Hepburn said: “Henk had to step into the role of Acting President just a few months after his election to Senior Vice President, and he did so unwaveringly. He guided the organisation through uncertain times, and his selection to President is a confirmation of the confidence placed in him. We wish him great success for his term.

“We also applaud Deon’s appointment as Senior Vice and we welcome Peet to the fold. The GolfRSA Board of Directors and I look forward to continuing the strong relationship with the SAGA office bearers going forward.”

Former Eastern Province Golf Union President Nel is excited to continue to build on the work done to further the game since his election to Junior Vice President in 2021.

“It was a privilege to work with Martin for a few short months and working closely with Henk and GolfRSA over the last ninth months has been very rewarding,” Nel said. “I look forward to the next two years and grateful that the SAGA Executive have placed their trust in Henk, Peet and myself. We have set ourselves a few targets and we are committed to achieving these goals.”

Van Schalkwyk represented North West from 1979 to 1998 and in 2020, he stepped into the managers role of the North West Premier Inter-Provincial Team. The 60-year-old area manager for a mining supply company began his administrative career with the union in 1995. After serving as Vice President from 2000 to 2006, he was elected President in 2007. He has also served on the SAGA Election Committee since 2020.

“It’s a great honour for me to join the SAGA Office Bearers and I look forward to working with Henk and Deon,” Van Schalkwyk said. “In the last few years, the SAGA has made exciting strides in golf development and the sustainability of the sport, and we are determined to maintain these high standards. On a personal level, junior golf is a particular passion of mine, and I am excited to have the opportunity to explore ways in which we can bring more juniors to the game at national level.”

### **2022 WINTER KNOCKOUT**

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- All male and female members whose subscriptions are paid to date or with payment arrangements may enter.
- Players eliminated in any round may NOT be used as a substitution in any future rounds (only 1 entry per member)

#### **ENTRY:**

- Entry fee of R 400-00 per team of 2 players to be paid before the draw takes place.
- **ENTRIES CLOSE ON FRIDAY 29 APRIL 2022.**
- Live draw will take place in our bar facility on Saturday 30 April 2022 at 18:00 pm and only fully paid-up teams will qualify for the draw.

#### **FORMAT:**

- 18 hole better-ball match play competition.
- Lowest handicap to play off scratch and other players to adjust individual handicaps accordingly.
- 95% of handicap will be played off for the duration of the Winter Knockout.

#### **PLAYING OF STIPULATED MATCHES:**

- Teams are responsible to arrange dates and times of matches. Please refrain from entering if you are not able to play on a consistent basis
- It is acceptable that opposing teams are not always able to play on the same day. The competition rules will however assume that, as a minimum, mutual agreement on play on a Saturday will be possible during the period permitted for a particular round. The team unable to play on any Saturday offered by the opposing team by the match date (or any other day by either team) will be treated as the team responsible for a round not being played within the given timeframe and will be the team disqualified. As a result, their opponents will advance to the next round.
- **NO EXTENSIONS WILL BE GRANTED FOR ROUNDS NOT PLAYED WITHIN STIPULATED TIMEFRAME**
- This will also apply to teams involved with other, or club related golfing activities such as league representation.
- Any dispute on the completion of a particular match of a stipulated round should be directed to the League Committee Convener, Brent Walbrugh (082 891 5097) or Kevin Torien (083 799 1292), whose decision on the matter will be final and binding to both teams.

#### **DECISION OF TIES:**

- If a game is tied after the completion of 18 holes, sudden death will apply starting from the same tee the match started on.

#### **RULES:**

- The rules of the game shall be set out by the R & A GOLF CLUB of St. Andrews and the local rules as posted on the scorecard and notice board of the club. No substitutions / changes may be made to teams during the competition.
- All rounds must be played at KRGC.
- **Handicap Index Not limited.** However, see "Hard Capped" below – Which is still applicable.
- Each player can decide for himself from which tee markers he will play on the day. (Yellow, Blue, Red).
- Strokes to be taken on adjusted handicapped holes.
- If only one player in a team is available to compete, the said player will be allowed to compete against the opposing 2 players.
- No player may play with an open round. This will result in a loss of the relevant better ball match if brought to the attention of the League Committee Convener on the same day of such match played.
- **As of 1 May 2022, all players HI will be "HARD CAPPED". This means that your HI can't increase from what it was before 1 May 2022, but can only decrease to a lower index if your accumulated play constitutes it.**

#### **COMPETITORS:**

- To ensure handicaps are correct prior to commencing play.

#### **PRIZES:**

- Prize money will be determined by the Convener, based on the amount of entries

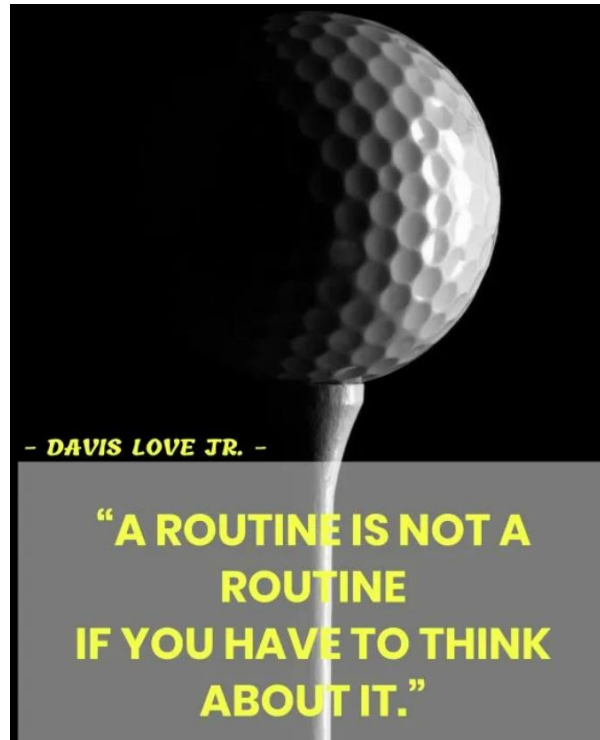
