Diesel Levy

As of Monday 06 February 2023 Kuilsriver Golf club will be implementing a Diesel levy of R15 for 18 holes and R10 for 9 holes.

Late in 2022 the club acquired a large 200kva generator to ensure that we can continue irrigating at night during load shedding times and maintain the current good condition of the golf course. As is evident, maintaining a good course condition has been achieved but the diesel cost associated with this has become exorbitant (as much as R70,000 per month). This is mainly attributed to the current stage 4 to 6 load shedding being experienced daily (very often at night), compounded by the fact that we are in an ESKOM supplied area and therefore get the worst of it.

It must also be noted that we have a smaller 6,5kva generator that is used during the day in the clubhouse to ensure that we manage the diesel costs by only using the large generator at night when irrigating. This smaller generator powers the point of sale systems, limited lights, TV/DSTV, PABX system etc. and we have also recently added the lights and extractor fan in the Kiosk to this generator to ensure continued operations and as little disruption as possible to our members and guests during the day.

The committee and management of KRGC thank our members for your continued support and are committed to ensure that we continue presenting a well-maintained golf course and services to our patrons during these very trying times.

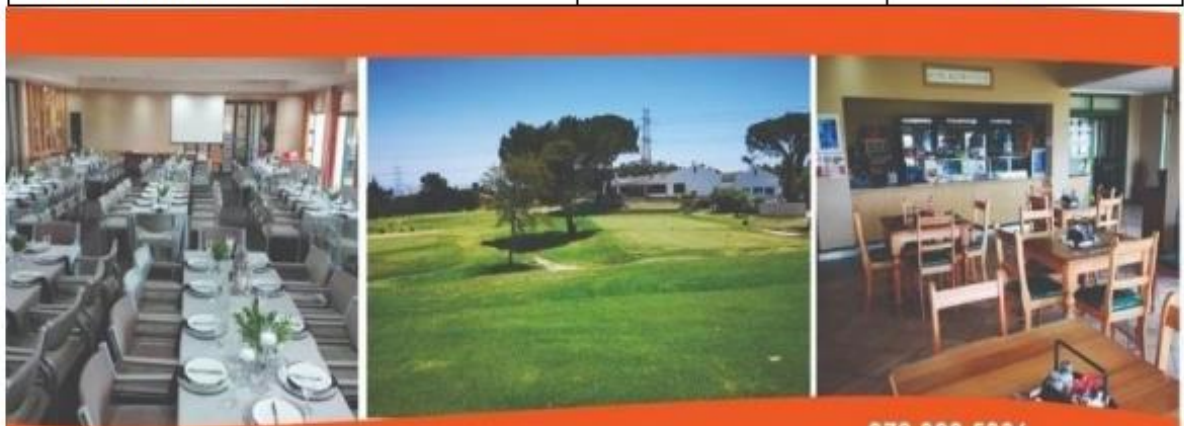

TIP FROM THYS...

Backswing blunders

Each part of the golf swing must link to the others for a consistent action. The takeaway dictates the backswing, which in turn affects the downswing and through swing. So, your backswing has to be correct if you're to deliver the blade powerfully square at impact.

Q

I work hard at getting my backswing on plane and have a smooth rhythmical action. I hit the ball straight but seem to lack a little power. What may be wrong?

A

Your action can be perfectly on plane throughout the swing – so it might look good to someone standing behind you – but this doesn't guarantee a powerful strike. If your backswing arc is too narrow you can't generate any real clubhead speed through the ball, as the tendency is to swing down on the same arc. A narrow backswing arc is produced from a poor extension of the arms on the takeaway combined with too much use of the wrists. You tend to pick the club up quickly with the arms tucked in. The swing arc becomes too cramped.

Widespread power

To create a wide arc, you must take the club back in one piece – so that your hands, arms and clubhead move away together for the first 45cm of your swing. Keep any wrist cock until later in your takeaway. And then hold the relative positions of the hands and shaft all the way to the top to ensure you keep the swing wide. The high-handed position at the top leads naturally to a good downswing with the clubhead on a powerful wide arc.
