TIP FROM THYS... *Hooking help*

Hooking doesn't have to be a result of an in-to-out swing path. It can also be caused by poor wrist action – perhaps bad positioning or excessive use. A wrong top of backswing position or a whippy action can close the clubface at impact – a sure route to a hook.

Question: I feel as though I'm swinging on the correct plane and path but still hit the occasional hook. What could I be doing wrong?

Answer: If you're not swinging from in to out, the only other way to hit a hook is to have a closed clubface at impact. You're almost certain to return the clubface closed if your blade is hut at the top of your backswing. If you have an arched wrist at the top – even if your club points parallel to the target line – the blade is shut. From here you naturally swing down and strike the ball with a closed clubface – unless you make drastic changes in your wrist position. The ball starts straight – as you attack it on the correct in-to-in path – but then curves left.

Flat wristed

To avoid a closed blade attack, your wrist has to be positioned correctly at the top of the backswing. The back of your left hand and your forearm must form a straight line for the blade to be square at the top. From this position you have a great chance of returning the blade square at impact.

Subject: TOURNAMENTS - GOLFRSA/NOMADS

To Provincial Unions,

ENTRY PROCESS CHANGE - ALL NOMADS GOLFRSA EVENTS

In order to streamline and maintain consistency in the entry process for all NOMADS GolfRSA events, it has been decided that player entries will, with immediate effect, be done through the Albatros Online Entry System.

Entrants will have to access the entry of tournaments via the GolfRSA Tournaments and Results TAB, as reflected on the GolfRSA website.

ALL NOMADS events including but not limited to the SA Boys, Coastal/Inland NOoM etc. once the closing date for entries have passed, unions will still be required to provide the Tournament Director a schedule of the qualifying players based on the entry criteria as set out in the Terms of Entry for specific tournaments.

Kindly ensure that communication, via the union offices are forwarded to your database, so as to ensure that all players who have previously participated and any other players who will in future participate in our tournaments, are advised of the new entry process.

NOMADS NATIONAL INLAND/COASTAL ORDER OF MERIT CHAMPIONSHIP

Eligibility

The Championship is open to any male amateur who must be under the age of 19 years at the commencement of

the Championship and must be a member of a club affiliated to GolfRSA or another similar International Body as

recognized by GolfRSA, who at the time of entry must have a **valid Handicap Index of 6.0 or less** as assessed in

terms of the World Handicapping System, or an equivalent handicap assessed under an alternative system

acceptable to GolfRSA.

All players must, at the close of entries, have a valid handicap index, failing which the player may be removed from

the list of entries irrespective of any Exemption categories which may apply.

Note: Any player entering may be subject to a handicap index check and any discrepancies or “penalty scores”

moving players within the handicap index limit or inside of any potential ballot, may result in the entry not being

accepted.

6. Exemption Criteria (to make up a maximum field of 72 in winter and 90 in summer)

In the event of GolfRSA receiving more than 72 entries, the following process will be used to finalize the field.

6.1 All golfers ranked in the top 20 places of the GolfRSA Boys U19 Rankings as of the closing date.

6.2 A maximum of 3 (4 in summer) nominations from each provincial union (these players must be in the top 3 (4

in summer) of the provincial Unions' junior rankings)

6.3 5 players nominated by SAGDB.

6.4 Players as invited by GolfRSA.

6.5 The remainder of the field will be made up of the GolfRSA Boys U19 Rankings. If the field is still not filled,

players' official HI will be used to determine the final player's list.

NOMADS S.A. BOYS U17 CHAMPIONSHIP

Eligibility

The Championship is open to any male amateur who must be under the age of 17 years at the commencement of the

Championship and must be a member of a club affiliated to GolfRSA or another similar International Body as recognized by

GolfRSA, who at the time of entry must have a valid Handicap Index of 4 or less as assessed in terms of the World Handicapping

System, or an equivalent handicap assessed under an alternative system acceptable to GolfRSA.

All players must, at the close of entries, have a valid handicap index, failing which the player may be removed from the list of

entries irrespective of any Exemption categories which may apply.

Note: Any player entering may be subject to a handicap index check and any discrepancies or “penalty scores” moving players

within the handicap index limit or inside of any potential ballot, may result in the entry not being accepted.

6. Exemption Categories

In the event of GolfRSA receiving more than 112 entries, the following players will be granted exemption from a ballot.

6.1 All golfers ranked in the top 30 places on the GolfRSA Junior - Boys U17 Rankings as of the closing date (DNQ does not qualify as Exempt).

6.2 The top 3 ranked players on their Provincial Union's Junior Order of Merit as of the closing date and who are not part of above. (NB - Players MUST fill one of the top 3 positions on their Unions Jnr OoM).

6.3 The eligible 5 players from the SAGDB who do not qualify as above on points 6.1 and 6.2.

6.4 Players as invited by GolfRSA.

6.5 International players as submitted by their National Golf Organizations who are under the age of 17 years at the

commencement of the tournament with a maximum Handicap Index of 4. (Number of exemptions may be limited at the

discretion of GolfRSA)

6.6 The remainder of the field, if still not filled, including a waiting list, will be made up using the South African Players' HI from

HNA computed as prescribed by the World Handicap System (WHS (with normal restrictions with regards to penalty

scores). All players who do not make the final players list will remain on a waiting list in the event of any withdrawals prior

to the start of the Championship.
