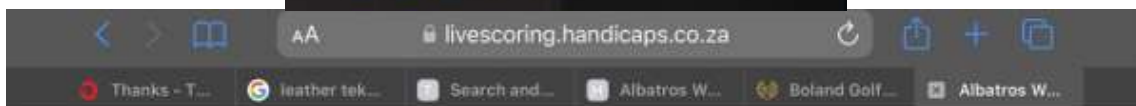

Dear Club Members,

We hope this message finds you well. As the management of your club, we would like to address an issue that has been affecting the overall experience for our members and guests. **It pertains to the importance of arriving on time for tee off and maintaining an appropriate pace of play throughout the round.** We kindly request your full attention as we discuss this matter, as it impacts the enjoyment of the game for all.

Firstly, we would like to emphasise the significance of punctuality. It is essential that players arrive at the tee box at least 10 minutes before their scheduled tee off time. This allows for an efficient and timely start to the game. Unfortunately, the persistent issue of late arrivals has become a serious concern, particularly on weekends. To address this matter, we will be implementing a new policy. Players who arrive late will be instructed to proceed to the back of the field, or in some cases, their game may be cancelled altogether. We understand that unforeseen circumstances can arise, but it is crucial to respect the designated tee off times in order to maintain a smooth flow of play for all participants.

Furthermore, we must address the issue of slow play during the round. Slow players significantly impact the pace of the game, leading to delays and an unpleasant experience for fellow members. To ensure a satisfactory pace of play, our dedicated marshals will be actively monitoring the course and engaging with individuals or groups who are impeding the progress of play. We kindly request that all members respect and cooperate with our marshals, as they are tasked with ensuring an enjoyable experience for everyone. It is their responsibility to address slow players and take appropriate action to rectify the situation.

In cases where a four-ball is unable to catch up to the group ahead, measures will be implemented to mitigate the impact on other players. These measures may include holding the four-ball back to join the rear of the field or, in more severe instances, removing them from the course. While we understand that these measures may seem drastic, they are necessary to ensure that all members can fully enjoy their game without unnecessary delays or frustrations.

We implore all members to consider the impact of their actions on the rest of the field. It is essential to remember that everyone is here to relish the game and have a memorable experience. By adhering to the rules and regulations regarding tee off times and pace of play, we can collectively create an environment that is enjoyable for all.

We want to assure you that if you or your four-ball are approached by our marshals or staff regarding these matters, it is solely due to a breach of the guidelines and the need for compliance. These interactions will be conducted respectfully and efficiently, with the sole aim of ensuring a fair and pleasant golfing experience for everyone involved.

We sincerely appreciate your cooperation and understanding in this regard. By taking these necessary measures, we can preserve the integrity of the game and create a positive atmosphere within our club. We value each and every member of our community and trust that this message will be received in the spirit in which it is intended.

Thank you in advance for your commitment to upholding the standards of our club and contributing to an enjoyable experience for all.

LEVEL 3 TOURNAMENT ADMINISTRATORS AND REFEREES SEMINAR (TARS) HOSTED BY
GOLFRSA

The R&A will be coming out to run a Level 3 Tournament Administrators and Referees Seminar (TARS) in South Africa. This Seminar presents a golden opportunity, for everyone involved in golf administration, to garner information in order to run more enjoyable and professional golf days, club championships and weekly club competitions.

At the TARS delegates will be given guidance and practical advice on running tournaments and refereeing, including sessions on course set-up, course marking, pace of play, suspension of play, starting and recording/scoring.



Venue: Steenberg Golf Estate, Cape Town, South Africa
Date: Monday, 30 October 2023 – Wednesday, 1 November 2023
Cost: R2 000
Closing date for entries: Friday, 29 September 2023

Entries will be capped at 80 delegates.

Process for entering

Once you get accepted into the seminar you will receive a return mail asking you to pay the entry fee.

Upon receipt of your proof of payment your contact details will be sent to The R&A who will send all registered delegates a link to create a user account for the R&A Rules Education Centre where The R&A will provide Preparation Guides and guidance on the Exam. The online Exam will also be made available on this platform, approximately three months prior to the seminar.

The Exam

Delegates are required to pass the R&A Level 3 Exam (80%+) in advance of attending the Level 3 TARS. Should a delegate fail to achieve the 80% pass mark, they may still be accepted to attend the Seminar on the condition that they take the resit exam within an agreed time frame, such as a month after the Level 3 Seminar. Without achieving the 80% mark, a delegate will not be able to graduate as Level 3, ie, no certificate will be issued confirming this.

Only following successful completion of the resit exam will a certificate be awarded to the delegate.



Note: Rules of Golf books will not be available for this seminar as The R&A have a policy to lessen their environmental footprint by not printing millions of copies of The Rules of Golf. Instead, the R&A Rules of Golf App can be used for preparation and the taking of the Rules Exam.

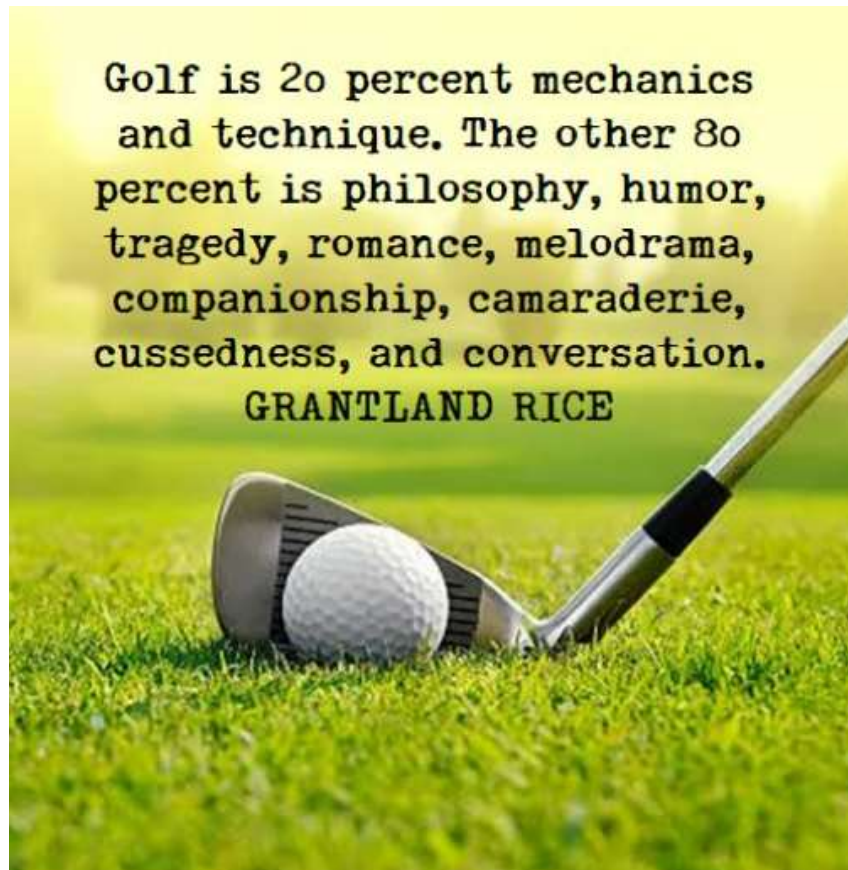
