We would like to inform you that the Golf Club Committee have decided to suspend the diesel levy until further notice. They will revisit the need to reintroduce this levy if circumstances change in the future.

One of the more extraordinary golf rules is the "relief from an embedded ball" rule, often referred to as the "plugged lie" rule. This rule allows a player to take relief without penalty if their ball becomes embedded in its own pitch mark in the ground in the general area (formerly known as "through the green"), except when the ball is embedded in sand in a part of the general area that is not cut to fairway height or less.

Here's how the rule works:

Identify if the ball is embedded: The ball must be embedded in its own pitch mark and not simply resting on the ground. The ball must have broken the surface of the ground.

Determine eligibility for relief: Relief is allowed in the general area, which includes all areas of the course except the teeing area, penalty areas, bunkers, and the putting green of the hole being played.

Taking relief:

Mark the spot: You should mark the spot directly behind where the ball is embedded.

Lift the ball: Carefully lift the ball from its embedded position.

Clean the ball: You may clean the ball once it has been lifted.

Drop the ball: Drop the ball within one club-length of the spot directly behind where the ball was embedded, no closer to the hole.

This rule is intended to provide relief when a ball is unfairly affected by ground conditions, such as soft or wet turf, and helps maintain the fairness of the game.
