**NB! Amendment, to No Placing...**

Dear Members... We wish to inform you of a directive from, The R&A, communicated via Golf RSA, which requires all unions to strictly enforce Rule 1. i.e. The practice of placing will no longer be the standard procedure applied by our course.

**Effective from 1 July, Model Local Rule 8E-2 will be implemented. This rule permits the marking, lifting, and cleaning of the ball, but it must be returned to its original spot without placing it elsewhere.**

Please be reminded that Rule 16.1b remains in effect, allowing players to take relief from abnormal course conditions, such as standing water etc.

## **Ben Hogan: The Miracle Comeback**

Ben Hogan was already a well-established professional golfer by the late 1940s, known for his incredible work ethic and precision. However, his career and life took a dramatic turn on February 2, 1949. Hogan and his wife, Valerie, were driving back to their Texas home from a tournament when their car collided head-on with a Greyhound bus in foggy conditions.

The accident was devastating. Hogan threw himself across his wife to protect her, which likely saved his life but left him with multiple life-threatening injuries. He suffered a double fracture of the pelvis, a fractured collarbone, a left ankle fracture, a chipped rib, and near-fatal blood clots. Many doubted he would ever walk again, let alone play golf.

Hogan's road to recovery was gruelling. He spent months in the hospital and underwent numerous surgeries. Despite his severe injuries and persistent pain, Hogan's determination and spirit were unwavering. He endured extensive physical therapy and worked tirelessly to regain his strength and mobility.

Astonishingly, just 11 months after the accident, Hogan made his return to competitive golf at the 1950 Los Angeles Open. He finished in a tie for first place but lost in a playoff. This remarkable performance was just a precursor to what would become one of the greatest comebacks in sports history.

In June 1950, Hogan entered the U.S. Open at Merion Golf Club. The tournament was a gruelling test of endurance, with 36 holes played on the final day. Hogan, still struggling with pain and fatigue, delivered an incredible performance. In one of the most iconic moments in golf, Hogan hit a 1-iron shot to the 18th green in the final round, securing a par and forcing an 18-hole playoff the next day. Hogan won the playoff, capturing his second U.S. Open title and solidifying his legendary status.

Hogan's victory at Merion became known as the "Miracle at Merion." He went on to win nine major championships in total, including three more after his accident. His determination, resilience, and sheer willpower have inspired countless athletes and fans.

Ben Hogan's story is a testament to the power of perseverance and the human spirit's ability to overcome incredible odds. His legacy continues to inspire golfers and sports enthusiasts around the world.
