The Story of Tom Morris's Lost Ball

Tom Morris, known as "Young Tom Morris," was a legendary Scottish golfer from the 19th century. During the Open Championship in 1870, he faced a tricky shot that could have cost him the title. In a rare moment of doubt, he hit his ball into a pond. Instead of abandoning the shot, he waded into the water, retrieved the ball, and carefully played it out, eventually winning the tournament.

What makes this story extraordinary is that Morris's integrity and perseverance under pressure became legendary. It's believed that he was the first golfer to demonstrate such honesty — retrieving and playing a ball from a water hazard rather than taking a penalty or dropping a new ball. His actions set a standard for sportsmanship that endures in golf to this day.

This story is rooted in history and showcases the true spirit of honesty and perseverance in golf.

Unfortunately, many members are either unaware of this change or have fallen out of the habit of submitting scores timeously.

VACANCY@ KRGC - Job Title: Golf Course Marshal / Starter

Reports To: Golf Operations Manager / Head Professional / General Manager

Position Summary:

The Golf Course Marshal / Starter is responsible for managing the flow of play on the golf course, ensuring that all golfers adhere to the club's rules and pace-of-play guidelines. This position is key in providing a welcoming, professional, and enjoyable golfing experience for members and guests.

Key Responsibilities:

Starter Duties:

- Greet members and guests warmly at the first tee.
- Check players in and confirm tee times, groupings, and handicaps.
- Explain course rules, local rules, and pace-of-play expectations to each group.
- Ensure all players have proper receipts, scorecards, and equipment before starting.
- Coordinate tee times to maintain an efficient flow onto the course.
- Call out next players on the tee and ensure tee times are adhered too
- Manage Marshal's on the course

- Manage time spent in the halfway house, including changing to grab and go when required
- All operations around golf cart management
- Perform Marshal function if required

Marshal Duties:

- Monitor pace of play throughout the golf course and communicate with groups that fall behind.
 - Assist players with course information, directions, and general queries.
 - Enforce course rules, etiquette, and safety regulations respectfully and tactfully.
 - Monitor the condition of the course (e.g., divots, ball marks, litter) and report issues to grounds staff.
 - Offer assistance in case of player emergencies or incidents.
 - Assist in locating lost clubs or personal items if reported.
 - Support tournament operations when required (player movement, rules clarification, etc.).
 - Maintain a visible and approachable presence on the course.

Skills & Qualifications:

- Friendly, approachable, and professional demeanour.
 - Good communication and interpersonal skills.
 - Ability to remain calm and polite under pressure or in conflict situations.
 - Strong understanding of the game of golf, rules, and etiquette.
 - Previous golf course or customer service experience preferred.
 - Reliable and punctual with a strong sense of responsibility.

Working Conditions:

- Mostly outdoor position; exposure to sun, wind, and varying weather conditions.
- Must be able to drive a golf cart and occasionally lift/move items (e.g., signage, equipment).
- Weekends, public holidays, and early mornings may be required.

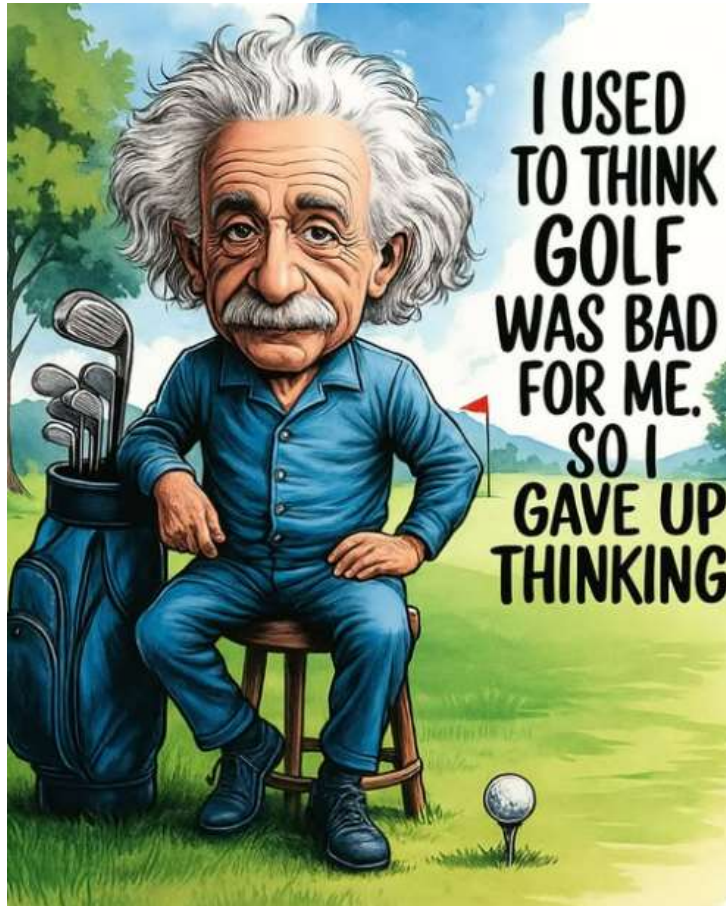
